Dear Assemblymember McCarty:

The Peace and Freedom Party of California, first qualified for the ballot in California over 50 years ago in reaction to the “Vietnam War” and the racist treatment of black and other people of color. Social, economic, and environmental justice has been a hallmark of the party since 1967. We are dedicated to real democracy, environmentalism, feminism, racial equality and socialism. We represent poor people especially those from the ghettos and barrios, those without a voice and those without hope.

Peace and Freedom Party supports AB 646, which would allow those on parole for a felony conviction to registrar to vote and vote if ACA 6 also passes. ACA 6 became law it would change the California to allow those on parole for a felony the right to vote. Peace and Freedom Party has been for expansion of voting rights by lowering the voting age, allowing non citizens to vote, allowing those imprisoned or on parole for most felony convictions, and many of those with certain mental issues. AB 646 resolves another restriction to voting rights.
