I am writing to you on behalf of the Peace and Freedom Party of California to strongly support Senate Bill 760.

This bill would require all schools, K-12, to provide at least one all-gender bathroom, fully stocked and easily accessible. It's shocking that legislative action is required for such an obvious need, especially when society is finally beginning to recognize the full spectrum of the human experience.

We would prefer that the mandated beginning date of this requirement would be sooner than Jan. 1, 2025 but we recognize that for some schools this will involve new construction.
